Term	Title	Unit summary	Assessment
1 2	Composition and Camera Skills	Students explore the importance of understanding how composition affects an image when taking photographs. Students combine this with the creative control of the camera functions to affect the use of light to create photographic effects.	Work is assessed holistically and will evidence students ability to: A01 Analyse photographer's work evidencing composition and camera functions A02 Experiment with ideas and digital techniques A03 Record ideas and observations using annotations, analysis, photographs, contact sheets and screenshots A04 Present final ideas linking outcomes to work.
3 4	Experimental and Concept Photography	Students investigate the cultural and social meanings behind photographs and the role of the photographer and use this to inform their own practice. They combine this with concepts of what is a photograph through experimenting with visual processes and both traditional and non-traditional photographic techniques.	Work is assessed holistically and will evidence students ability to: A01 Analyse photographer's Dianne Arbus and Keld Helmer-Petersen work A02 Experiment with concepts, meanings and ideas and digital techniques A03 Record ideas and observations using annotations, analysis, photographs, contact sheets and screenshots A04 Present final ideas linking outcomes to the photographer's studied.
5 6	Gallery Response and Summer Exam	Students develop their own project based upon visit to the Liverpool art galleries. They analyse, record and document ideas and experiments to produce a final outcome. The summer exam encourages a practical response to a chosen question within a supervised 5 hour supervised.	Work is assessed holistically and will evidence students ability to: A01 Analyse photographer's work A02 Experiment with ideas and digital techniques A03 Record ideas and observations using annotations, analysis, photographs, contact sheets and screenshots A04 Present final ideas linking outcomes work.
