4	Hinduism 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Explore our first dharmic faith. Examine the concept of Hinduism as a monotheistic faiths and the various avatars of Brahman. Explore the core beliefs of the Hindu faith. Examine types and places of worship. Explore festivals, their origins and meaning for Hindu's today. Evaluate the concept of the Caste system. 	<p>Summative assessment: Various explain and evaluate questions on Hindu beliefs, festivals and an evaluative question on The caste system.</p>

6	Buddhism 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Explore core beliefs of the philosophy of Buddhism. Examine the life of Siddhartha Guatama and how he became the Buddha. Explore key concepts – the eightfold path, the four noble truths and the five precepts. Examine how Buddhists meditate and the life of a Buddhist monk. 	<p>Summative assessment question Various short multiple choice questions and a longer extended writing piece. "The Four Noble Truths are the most important Buddhist teaching." Evaluate this statement.</p>
