

Re: Sixth Form Catch-up Funding

Sixth Form students who did not achieve a grade 4 in English language or maths GCSEs at the end of Year 11 will have access to a programme of small group intervention sessions. These will consist of around five students working with a dedicated teacher/tutor and will take place out of school hours.

Eligible students will also have been identified as being at risk of underachieving based on current assessment data.

These sessions will be funded from the catch-up grant awarded to the school as part of the DfE's recovery package of support, for 16-19 year olds.

This equates to £5462 of additional investment in tuition support.

Students will be contacted directly by their subject teachers if this option is available to them. Programme of intervention will start from January 2022. The tracking and progress of our students as a result of this additionality will be reviewed over the course of the school year..
