Why do Work Experience?



- It is an opportunity to sample different types of careers / jobs
- It is a compulsory part of your careers curriculum
- It will be a requirement for some University courses / Apprenticeship applications
- It is a chance to make yourself stand out when competing for a place at University or for an Apprenticeship / Job
- It will give you the chance to understand the difference between being at school and work
- It will give you an opportunity to sample some ideas about your future without making a long term commitment
- It is fun! A week away from school 😊

Things to consider

What are your career interests in the future?

What are you thinking about doing after school?

Not all types of organisations can offer work experience it is important to be realistic when finding a placement

Work experience is not a wasted experience, you will always be able to talk about the things you have learnt !

What does the local jobs market offer?

You need to find your own work experience placement



You may have personal connections who can help you find a placement you are really interested in



Employers often appreciate the bravery of being approached by the person wanting the placement



It makes you look more motivated and enthusiastic - employers or universities will look on you more favourable

There is no such thing as “I can’t find a placement”

- Are there companies you are already aware of in your local area?
- Do you have friends or family members working in these areas who can help?
- Use the internet to research local companies in the fields you are interested in.
- Make yourself a list and research into each company to find out more about what they do, using their websites and social media pages.
- Phone / Email / visit companies and ask if they will take you on Work Experience



What is Unifrog ?



This is a work experience admin management tool.

It is **not** a searchable database of placements.

The tool should start to be used by the student, **once they have found a placement.**
