As part of the Geography A-Level, students are to complete NEA coursework which is worth 20% of their overall grade.

**NEA Manchester & Liverpool** - These fieldtrips will allow students to use their prior knowledge and understanding on the module 'Changing Places', whilst participating in fieldwork on sustainable transport in Manchester city centre, one of the leaders in this field, and land use change in Liverpool, a dynamic city centre.

**NEA Blackpool** - This fieldtrip will allow students to use their prior knowledge and understanding on the module 'Coasts', whilst participating in fieldwork on management strategies at Rossall beach and further south towards Blackpool.
