PURPOSE

The Duke of Edinburgh's Award develops children's skill physically, mentally and socially. It is a challenge but also an extremely fulfilling expererience.

The Silver Award consists of four sections; Volunteering, Skill, Physical activity and a 30 mile expedition. Please see the award website, www.dofe.org , for details of qualifying activities and requirements. Students are also required to register on eDofE, terms and conditions are available at

www.eDofE.org

Please note that, whilst students are undertaking Skill, Volunteering and Physical sections it is the responsibility of the parent/guardian/carer to ensure that the activity is properly managed and insured, and that the adults are suitably qualified and checked.

All Expedition Training/Practice sessions are compulsory for students to give them the necessary grounding in the Award and to develop the essential mental and physical qualities/skills for the Expedition.

DofE Silver requires two residential trips; a practice and a qualifier. Further information will be sent out for both of these.

DofE Silver Practice will take place on 19th April – 21st April 2024.

DofE Silver Test will take place on 28th June – 30th June 2024.
