The day has been arranged to provide students with a range of options in terms of both activity and cost.

SHOULD MY CHILD GO?

These trips are intended as a reward and expectations of students to earn this reward were shared with them earlier this term. Students with a positive house point balance will automatically be allowed to attend one of the offsite activities, subject to obtaining behaviour standards in the next half term. Expectations are linked to: attendance and punctuality (to school and lessons) and in and out of class behaviour. Should students contravene these

expectations, they will not be able to be included in the reward trip. We cannot guarantee to refund costs in these circumstances as tickets will have been purchased (see booking
