Liverpool - Students will visit Liverpool City Centre and the Albert Dock. This will support with their wider understanding of the module 'Urban Issues and Challenges', with a focus on regeneration in a UK city.

Formby - Students will visit Formby Beach sand dunes. This will support with their wider understanding of the module 'Coastal Landscapes of the UK', with a focus on sand dune development and coastal management.

Students will develop their fieldwork skills in preparation for Y11 and their Paper 3 Geographical Application exam
