<p><b>English</b></p> <p>Research one of the following plays by Shakespeare: <i>The Tempest</i>, <i>Much Ado About Nothing</i>, or <i>Twelfth Night</i>.</p> <p>You should research the plot, characters and previous stagings of the play.</p> <p>Choose how to represent your research: as a booklet, as a poster, as a piece of artwork, or as designs for your own theatre production.</p>	<p><b>Art</b></p> <p><b>Colour mood</b></p> <p>Mark Rothko painted huge rectangular shapes of colour, known as The Seagram Murals. Have a look at them.</p> <p>Think of times when you feel, happy, sad, lonely or even confused. Create colour shapes that reflect how you're feeling.</p>	<p><b>Computing</b></p> <p>You are a level designer for <b>PixelJump! Studios</b>. They want fresh ideas for their new platform game. Your level must be creative, challenging and fun.</p> <p><b>Project Brief</b></p> <p>Design a complete level for a new platform game, including character design and rules.</p> <p><b>Tasks</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Sketch a level map: platforms, hazards, collectibles.</li><li>- Create a character profile.</li><li>- Describe at least 4 mechanics.</li><li>- Write game rules (win/lose, scoring).</li><li>- Create a short storyboard for the start of the level.</li></ul> <p><b>What to Hand In</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- A page containing your map, profile, rules and storyboard.</li></ul> <p><b>Stretch Challenge</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Add difficulty settings.</li></ul>

Present your findings as a poster, slideshow, or short booklet. Include images and a simple reflection on what you found most interesting and how the faith promotes unity and peace.</p>

<p><b>Science</b></p> <p>Research sedimentary, igneous and metamorphic rocks.</p> <p>Include examples of each, uses, properties and how they are formed.</p>	<p><b>History</b></p> <p>Research <b>life in a medieval village</b>. Create a <b>detailed map or model</b> of a medieval village, including buildings like the <b>village hall, blacksmith's forge, farmer's hut</b>, and <b>church</b>. Show where different activities took place (e.g., markets, festivals, farming).</p> <p><b>Challenge:</b> Write a '<b>day in the life</b>' story from the perspective of a child, farmer, or craftsman in the village. Include what they would have done for work, leisure, and religious activities, and describe what medieval food would have been like.</p>	<p><b>PE</b></p> <p>Track your basic daily habits for 3–5 days (e.g. bedtime, amount of sleep, number of minutes doing physical activity, number of minutes screen time, meals). Write a short reflection on how these affect your health and then explain whether you feel you could improve any of the metrics and why.</p>
<p><b>MFL</b></p> <p><b>Year 7 Spanish – Free Time Poster</b></p> <p>Students create a colourful poster about their favourite free time activity and include at least one simple sentence in Spanish (e.g. <i>En mi tiempo libre, me gusta escuchar música</i>). The focus is on key vocabulary such as <i>me gusta</i> and common hobbies.</p> <p><b>Year 7 French – Je me présente Poster</b></p> <p>Students create a poster introducing themselves in French. They should include basic information such as their name, age, where they are from and details about their family.</p>	<p><b>Geography</b></p> <p><b>UK Seaside</b></p> <p>Plan a seaside holiday ! Plan a 4-day holiday in a UK seaside town for the summer holidays. Create a leaflet or poster about your chosen holiday destination. You could choose Llandudno, Barmouth, Newquay, Swanage.
