They want a unique concept with clear mechanics, characters, and visuals.</p> <p><b>Project Brief</b></p> <p>Create a professional game concept pitch for a new title.</p> <p><b>Tasks</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Name your game and describe the story premise.</li><li>- Create your main character(s).</li><li>- Draw UI ideas (health bar, menus).</li><li>- Describe the game loop (what players do repeatedly).</li><li>- Write a 150-word pitch.</li></ul> <p><b>What to Hand In</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Concept page + UI sketch + pitch.</li></ul> <p><b>Stretch Challenge</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Add a monetisation idea (cosmetics, unlocks).</li></ul>
